Analysis of the overall feedback

The above results of Alumni feedback form were calculated for the session 2014-2015 for all the departments in the college. And, the sample of 100 Alumni was taken into consideration. The majority of Alumni rated Admission procedure and Alumni Association as Excellent and very good. Furthermore, the college infrastructure such as the canteen facilities, Hostel Facilities, infrastructure & lab facilities and library resources were rated high and majority of opinions falling in Excellent and very good. Also, the faculty of the college, skill courses in college, courses studied by alumni and learning experience of alumni was excellent and very good clearly elucidating that college from British times has been epitome of learning.

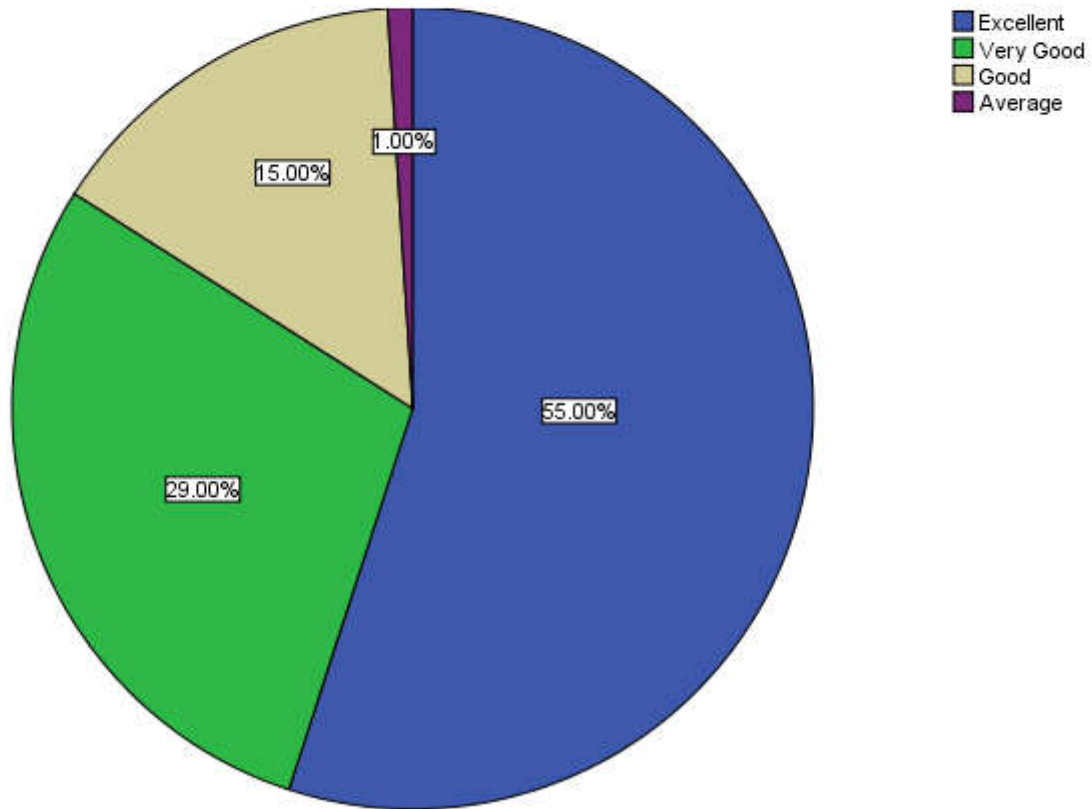

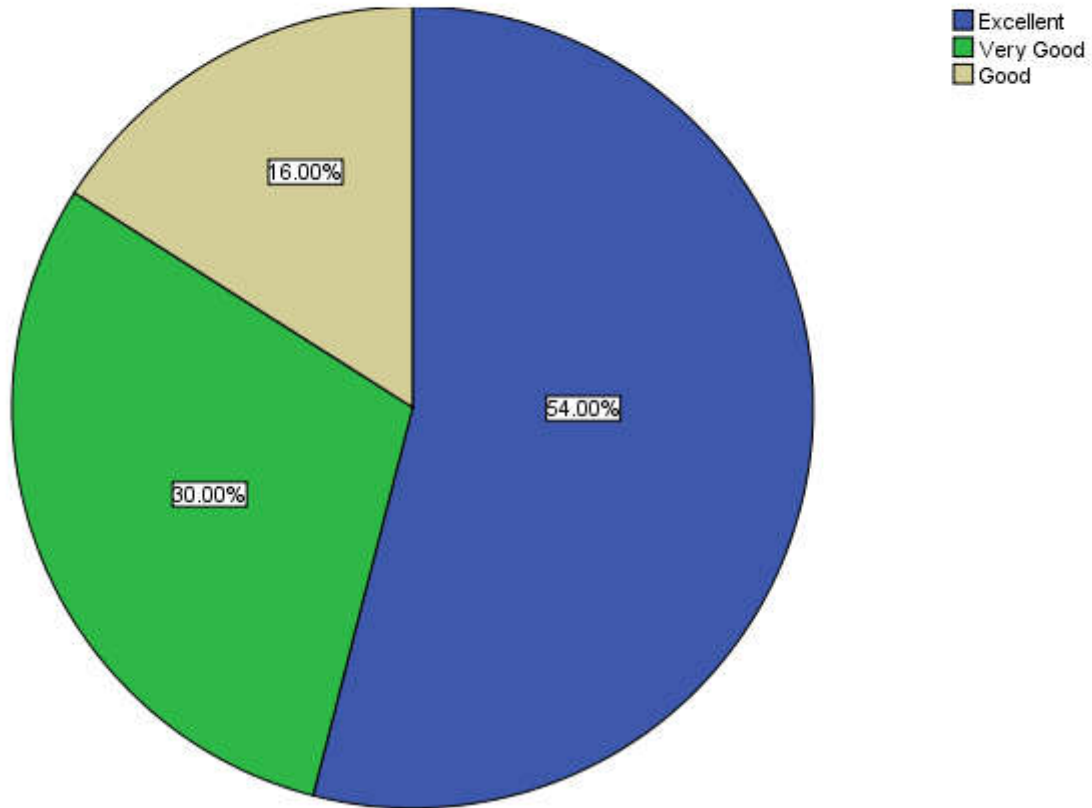

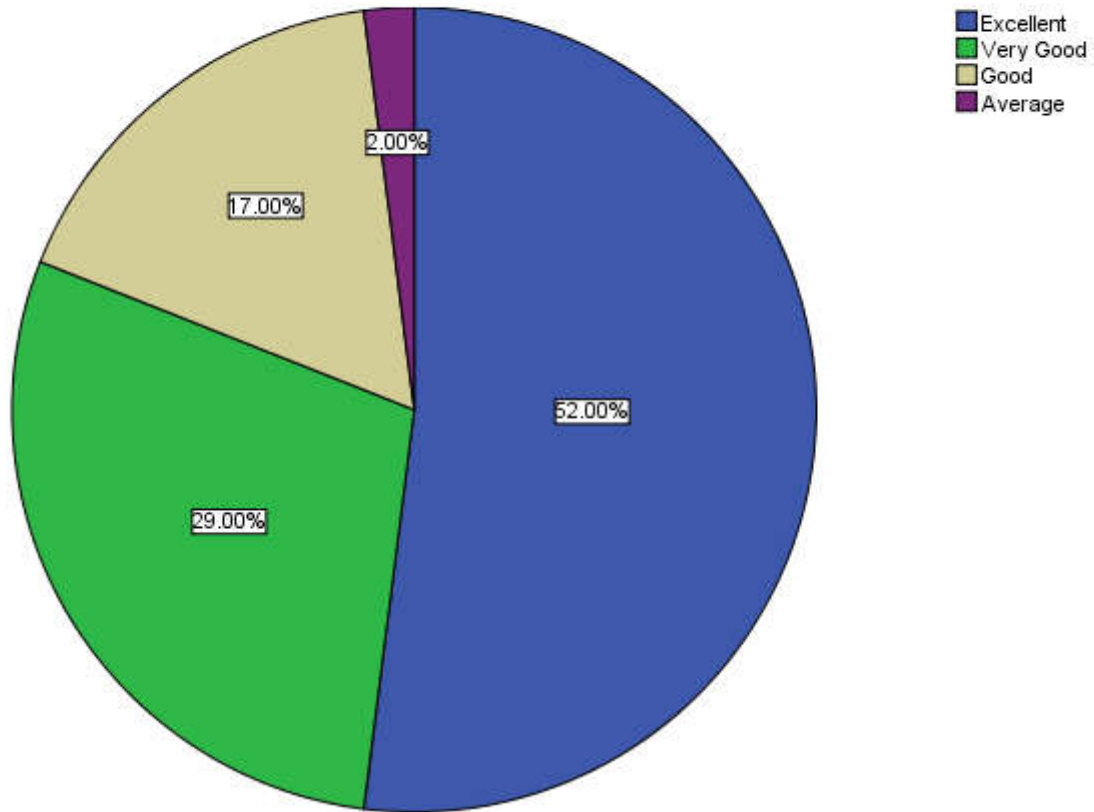
Relationship with peers/subordinates

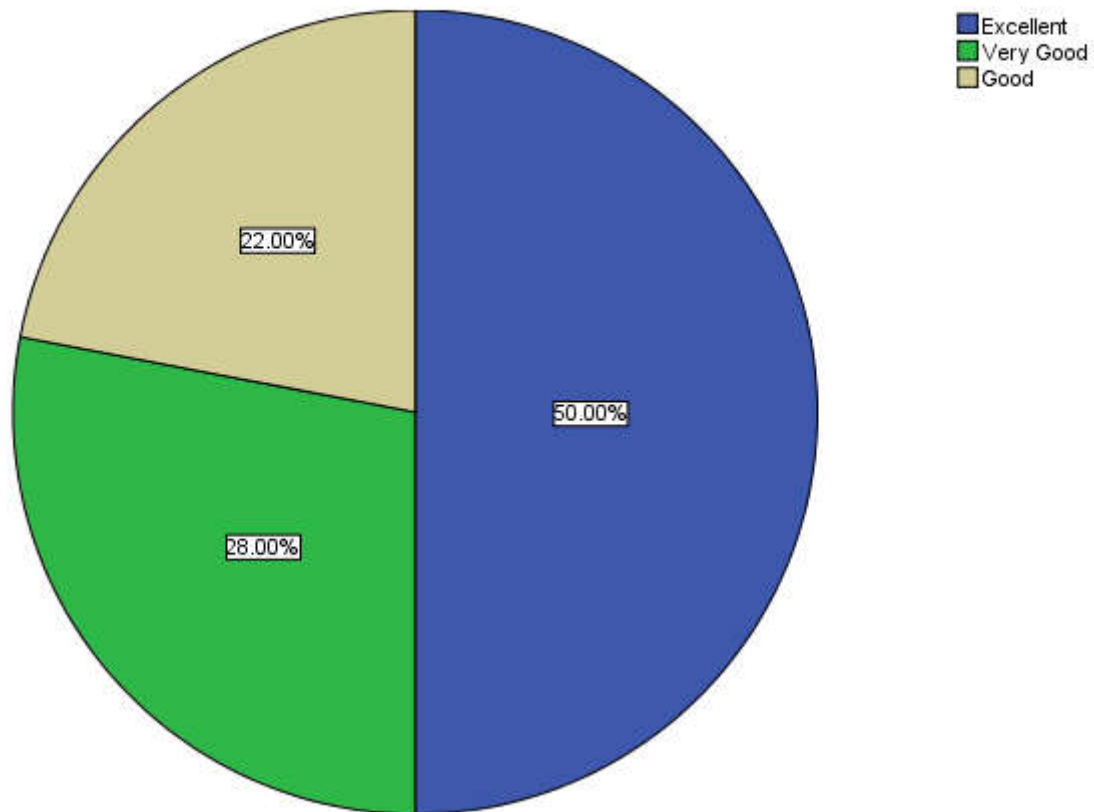
Involvement in social activities and degree of responsibility taken

Analysis of the overall feedback

The above results of employers feedback form were calculated for the session 2014-2015 for all the departments in the college. And, a sample of 100 employers was taken into considerations which were both government and private companies. The government degree college is a very old college and each year many students get placed in government and private sectors. Though, many of the students also go for higher education in Masters and PhD Programs.

In the questionnaire feedback form 23 questions or statements were there which broadly represented three dimensions such as design and review of Syllabus, infrastructure of the college and performance level of students selected by employers.

Design and Review of Syllabus:

In this section there were three questions i.e. Curriculum Relevant for employability; Current syllabus is need based and effectiveness of curriculum. And, nearly majority of opinion came in form of excellent, very good and good in all three statements, which clearly favoured the syllabus and curriculum in the college.

Infrastructure of the College:

With regard to infrastructure of the college, seven (7) questions or statements were asked with regard to faculty, infrastructure, library, Lab & ICT Facilities, environment, experience with college faculty & staff and hospitality given by the college. And, majority opinion was in favour of the infrastructure of college (84%), in which all options selected by employers were excellent, very good and good. With regard to faculty (77%), experience with college faculty & staff (82%) and Hospitality (83%) given by the college, also good results were there. As, for maximum employers selection of option fell in excellent, very good and good.

This clearly proves that government college Dharamshala has excellent infrastructure and faculty which has been responsible for the success of its students in various fields.

Performance level of Students:

With regard to the performance level of the students, 12 questions or statements were asked. The questions were related to General communication skills, honesty, attitude, finding practical solutions, team spirit, self motivation, innovation & creativity, contribution towards goal, technical knowledge and skills, manager and leader qualities, relationship with peers and with regard to involvement in social activities. And in all questions, the response of the employers was very positive and good. All the maximum employers gave their opinion as excellent, very good and good, which clearly depict a charismatic and stunning image of the students/alumni of the college.

The last question was asked to rate the college out of 10 stars for overall satisfaction level of employer with regard to infrastructure, students and curriculum of the college. And the opinion of the employers was very positive. And, all opinion came as 10 stars, 9 stars and 8 stars clearly explaining the charismatic image of the college, since the British times.

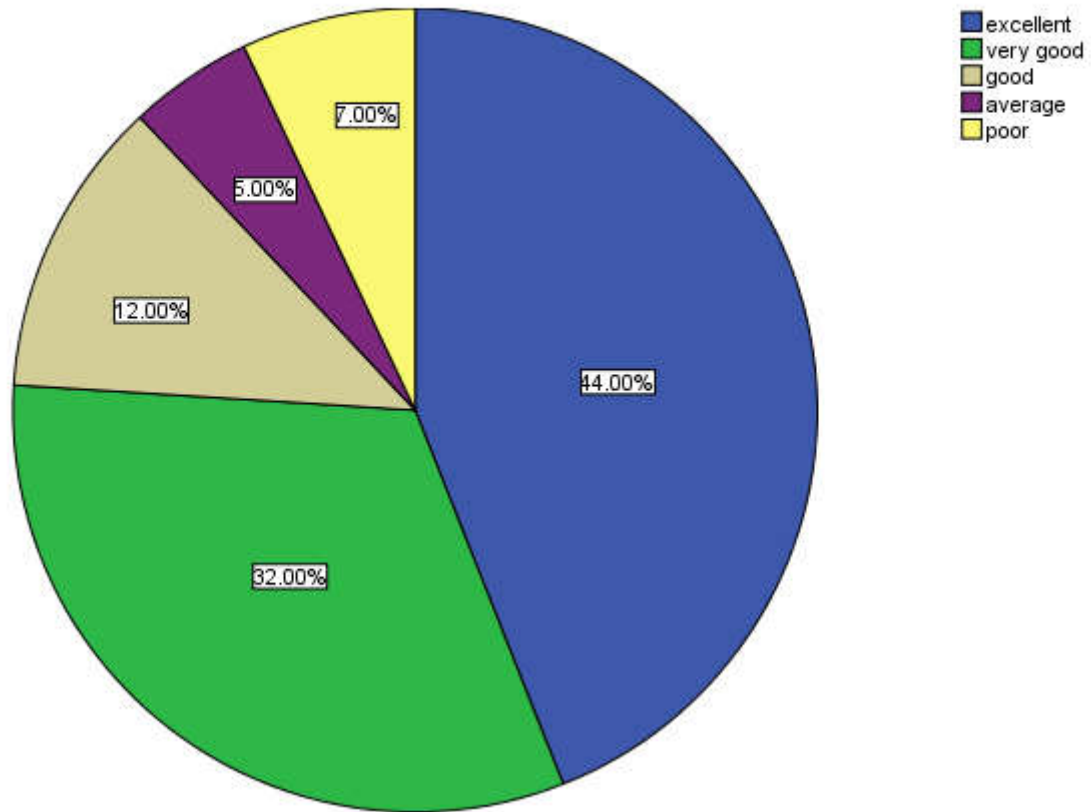
Summary of the overall Analysis

Summary of the overall Analysis

The above results of Parent feedback form were calculated for the session 2014-2015 for all the departments in the college. And, the sample of 100 Parents was taken into consideration. The parent's opinion in feedback was very positive. Evaluation of the Student's Feedback

The above results of Student feedback form were calculated for the session 2014-2015 for all the departments in the college. And, the sample of 100 students randomly analyzed from the 1000 feedback forms filled in the college. The criterion taken for choosing the students was that those students were selected, whose attendance was above 75% and who appeared for mid-term examinations. From the 1000 feedback, only 100 questionnaires randomly were selected (every 10th form). This methodology was adopted, so that the tool could not be used as a tool of fault finding of teachers. Rather, the emphasis was given to teaching methodology, assessment practice, support systems and improvement in the course content. Also, the scope of infrastructure was seen from the perspective of the students.

The overall contentment level of the students was satisfactory with regard to the course covered in each semester and with relevance of the course. The majority of the students (69%) agreed that there was no overlap with the other courses and also that recommended reading was adequate and relevant. The maximum students (77%) agreed that the midterm and class tests were conducted as per the schedule and was satisfactory. Further, 82% students agreed that the syllabus was completed well on time. The teacher subject knowledge (78%), teacher communication (70%), teacher preparedness (62%), teacher

encouragement (67%) & teaching aids (62%) was acknowledged by the students and maximum students agreed with these statements.

The teacher attitude (53%), availability (73%), and evaluation (70%) also received maximum weight age from majority of students. With regard to curriculum improvement various recommendations were received from students like summer training, industrial training, job trends to be taken into consideration, modern technology in laboratory, introduction of various subject related software's, revision of some portions of course content and smart room provision in some departments.

Also, some suggestions were suggested for the teachers such as communication during lectures in both Hindi & English, practical knowledge to be made part of the syllabi, monotonous teaching methods to be avoided, live projects made part of the course, too much theoretical knowledge in some subjects should be replaced and more academic plus extra-curricular events organized for students for holistic development of the students.

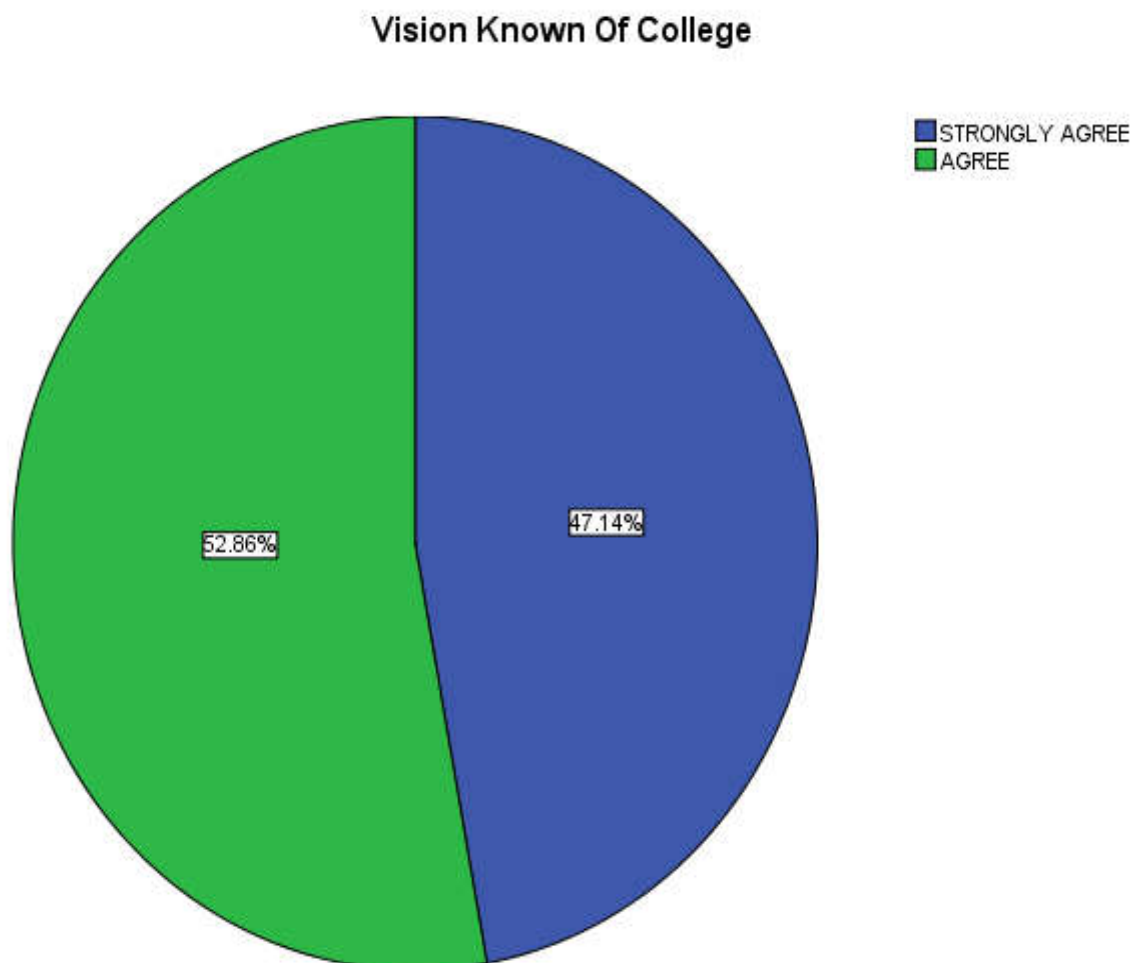

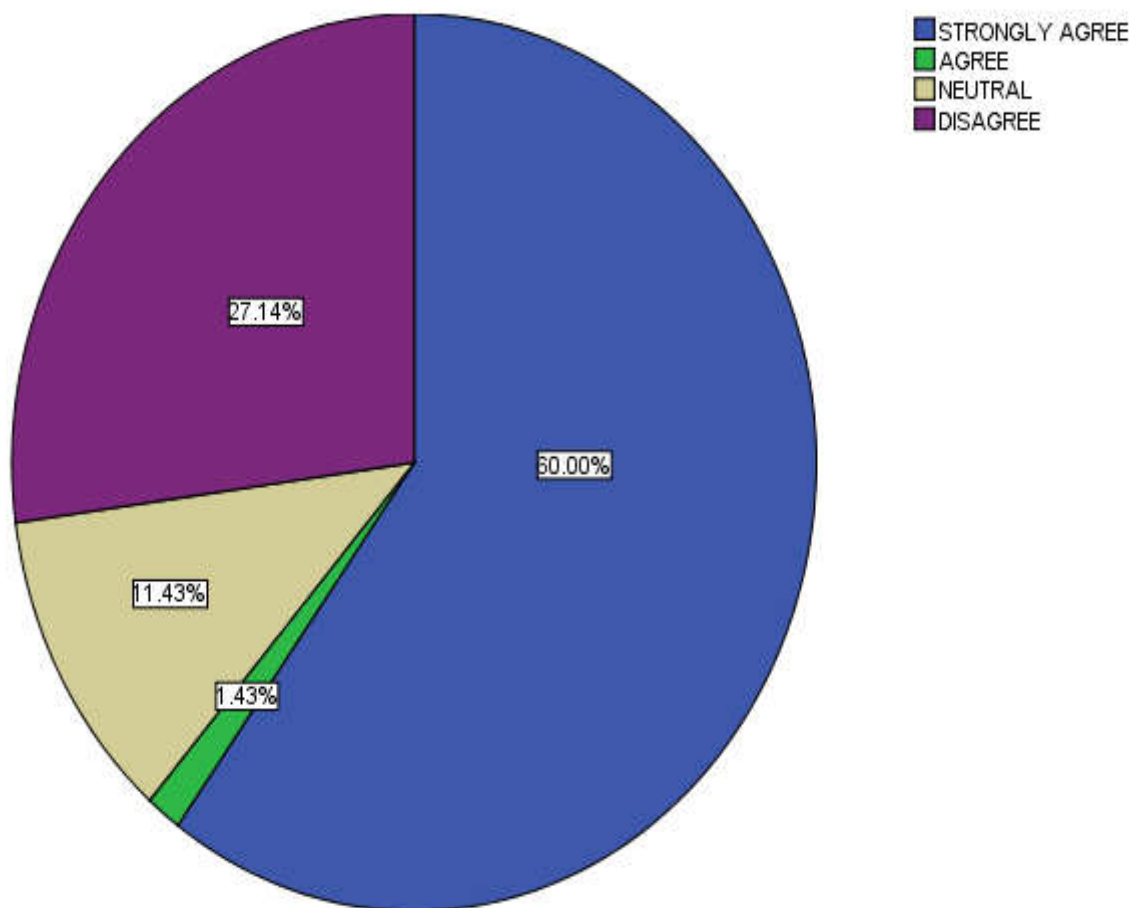

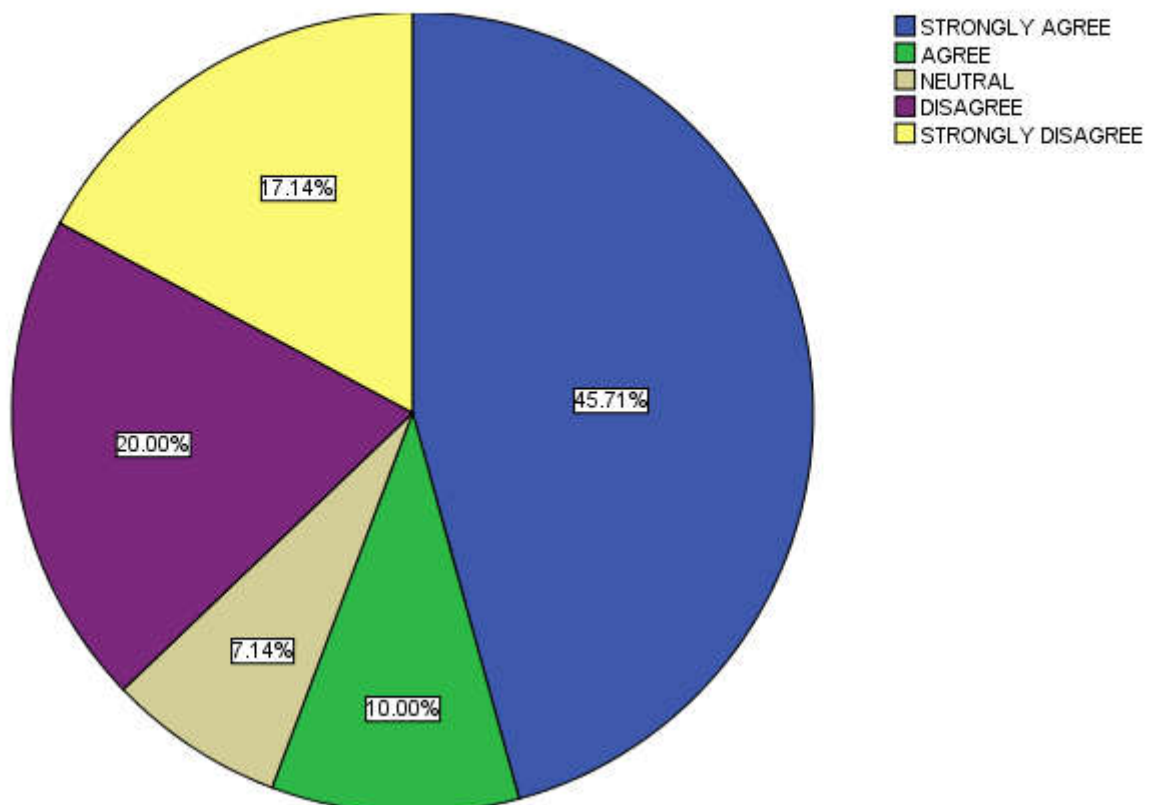

Evaluation of the Teacher's Feedback

The above results of Teacher feedback form were calculated for the session 2014-2015 for all the departments in the college. And, the sample of 70 faculties was taken into consideration. The teacher's opinion in feedback was very optimistic. The majority of teachers knew about the vision of the college along with the aim of syllabi. And, according to them students were also clear about the aim of the syllabi. Also, according to faculty sufficient optional papers present in the course (61.4%), programme outcomes of syllabi are well explained (48.6%), curriculum had good academic flexibility (61.4%) and course contents were able to fulfill student needs (50.4%) as maximum responses were in good and very good. Though contrary to it, some faculty felt that there was need to add some optional papers (27.1 %), programme outcomes of syllabi needed explanation (30%), curriculum needed more academic flexibility (25.7 %) and course contents must be reviewed to fulfill student needs (48.6 %).

The majority of faculty disagreed (48.6%) that the syllabus did not needs to be reviewed, while 38.6% faculty agreed to review the syllabus. The teachers were also satisfied (67.1%) with the discipline of the students and students gave full respect to them. The maximum faculty also agreed (61.4%) that colleges provided them opportunities for continuous development of staff and provided equal opportunities for staff. Also, the majority of teachers agreed that college provided adequate medical facilities (51.4%); along with rest-rooms, toilets, grounds, classrooms (40%); clean drinking water (37.1%); laboratory requirements (42.9%) and computer facilities for teaching (41.4%).

The maximum teachers disagreed (51.5%) that encouragement was given for their endeavors in research; conservation of environment and waste management practices was done (42.9%). However, maximum teachers agreed that college authorities were always approachable & accessible (44.3%); mechanism of feedback, review and performance enhancement (42.9%) and recognition/incentive/appreciation of Individual work (55.7%).
