***STAFF**

The college has a total number of 76 sanctioned posts in the teaching faculty, and out of these 57 posts are filled on regular bases, 5 on contract and 14 posts are lying vacant out of which 4 have been filled on PTA in various subjects. In the non-teaching staff, the college has 43 sanctioned posts and out of which 25 are filled up on a regular basis and 18 are lying vacant in various categories.

The total student strength after college is 6420 out of which are 3408 girls and 3012 are boys.

***LIBRARY**

The college has a spacious and magnificent library which is completely computerized and has 68957 books on various subjects. There are 41 new books added to the textbook section

resulting in 16966 text books in all. In general books section the total books are 47376. In the current session 13 newspapers and 22 magazines in English and Hindi are subscribed for the students. The Library of self-financing courses is fully automated. The General library is also going to be completely automated in the coming days. It has a fully operational INFLBNET system.

***SELF FINANCING DEPARTMENTS**

***BCA-Coordinator Dr. Raghubir Barsola**

The college started BCA course from the session 2010 under the self-financing scheme and sixty students were admitted in this course in every session through entrance exam. But due to covid-19, the students were admitted on the basis of their 12th marks. Out of 60 seats, forty seats are under subsidized category and twenty seats are under non-subsidized category. The course has added a new chapter in the achievement of the institution. The department has excelled in all activities and is a matter of great pride that in the current session, two students of BCA 6th semester (Priyanshu Kumar Bhatti and Rajat Thapa) got selected for the final round of Wipro technologies. In this session three students of BCA 6th semester got selected in CHPU for MCA and some of others are selected in HPU Shimla for higher studies. The mission of this course remains to develop the personality of the students and make them capable to be selected in higher courses in good universities as well as to be selected in good IT companies.

***MCA - Coordinator Dr V.S Vats**

Master of Computer Applications was started in the college from the session 2012. MCA department is well equipped computer labs, new furniture, and writing boards and requisite number of lecture halls. It is a three –year program spread over six semesters to bridge the chasm between computer studies and applications bringing within reach of enthusiastic youngsters by excellent youngsters by an excellent group of experienced and dedicated staff, and an enviable infrastructure. Two Day workshop under TEQIP-III was organised in the month of February. One month MCA Orientation program was conducted in the month of March. One week Orientation programme was held in the month of Oct.-2021. An Industrial tour was organised in the SASE Manali, in the month of Dec-2021.

***PGDCA-Coordinator:Prof Rajnish Dewan**

The first batch of PGDCA was started in the session 2007-08 with 40 seats (+1Supernumerary single girl child).Out of 40, 30 seats are in the category of subsidized and the remaining 10 seats are under the non-subsidized category. It is matter of great pride that the students of this department got placements in various public and private sectors. The mission of this course remains to develop the personality and talent of the students and make them capable and carve a niche for themselves in the modern age of Information and Technology.

Fort this academic session 75 students applied online, and after applying the 120 point Roster, all 40 seats were filled.

The department is running successfully in government PG college Dharamshala since 1997. The management is continuously aiming to meet the objectives of training and meeting manpower requirements of junior management positions in 2021-2022. There are 171 students in total in all three semesters for this session.

In order to give the opportunity to the students to fulfil the requirement of the corporate world special emphasis is given on the Placements of the students in the Department. Department is planning to have a collaborative Placement Drive with different organizations in which students will get a chance to fulfil the requirements of the Corporate World and the process has already been initiated. Most of the students of Final Semester got placed in various organizations like Just Dial, ICICI Prudential Life Insurance, Edu. Culture Pvt. Ltd. etc.

***B.Tech in Computer Sciences.**

The School of Computer Science and Engineering at Govt. College Dharamshala offers B. Tech.(Computer Science and Engineering) and Master in Computer Applications(MCA) programme to create motivated, innovative, creative thinking graduates to fill ICT positions across sectors who can conceptualize, design, analyse, and develop ICT applications to meet the modern day requirements.

B.Tech (CSE) is a four-year degree course spread over eight semester's course and MCA is a three year degree course spread over six semesters affiliated to Himachal Pradesh Technical University Hamirpur. These courses are approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi. The School of Computer Science & Engineering

has requisite number of theatre seminar halls and well-equipped AC computer laboratories having more than 60 latest computers with internet facility. The department provides industrial visits and training, seminars, workshops on latest software technologies and study tours to the students. The college has a career guidance and placement cell which is working very efficiently for the placement of students in MNCs. The department has a well-qualified and trained faculty as per AICTE norms.

The department has organized one week induction program, an industrial visit was also organized for the students. The department has organized one day seminar on IT & Latest Trends By ALT Campus Services Pvt. Ltd. Apart from this department has organized various online and offline workshops/seminars for this session. More than 25 Students are placed with companies like I-Cube Systems Pvt. Ltd., TCS, GAI Technologies for this session. The faculty has published and presented various research papers and books.
