

Analysis of Feedback by Teachers

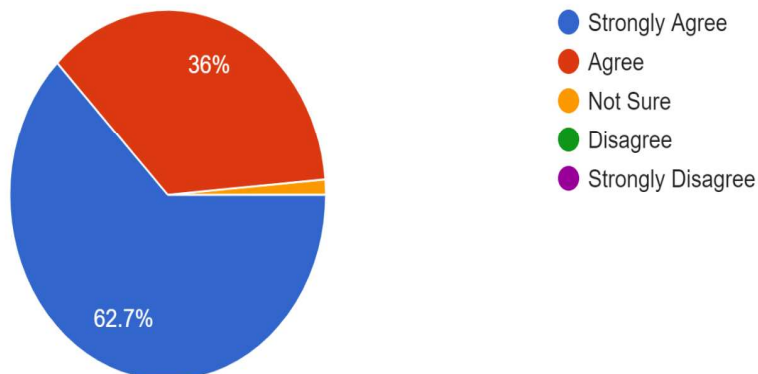

The twenty three factors/Questions constitute each questionnaire and their analysis is as follows:

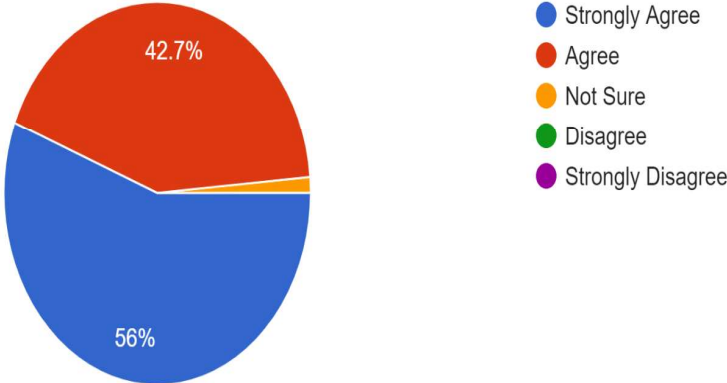
The Vision, philosophy & objectives of the College are known

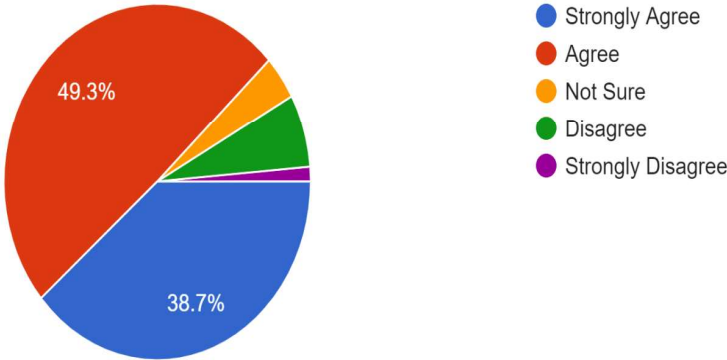
Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students.

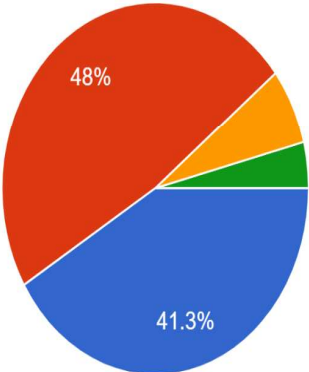
The course/programme of studies carries sufficient number of optional papers.

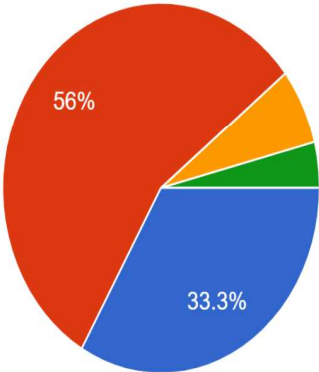

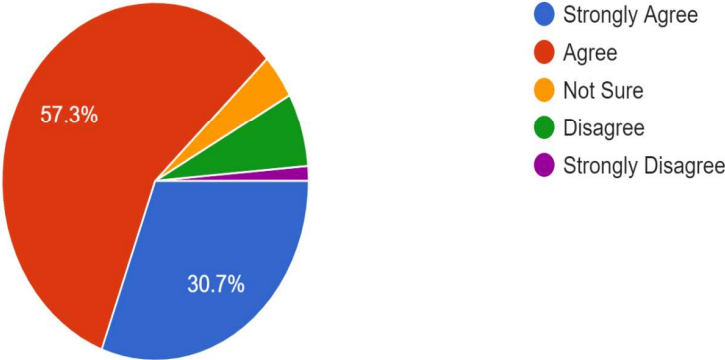

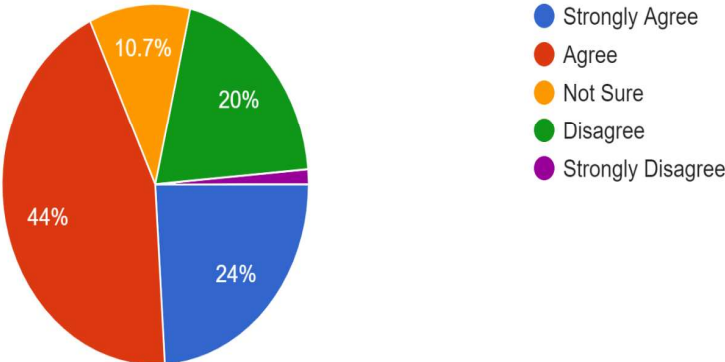
The course content fulfils the need of students

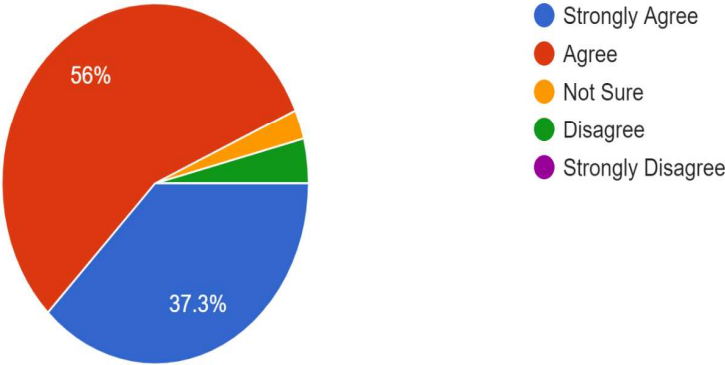

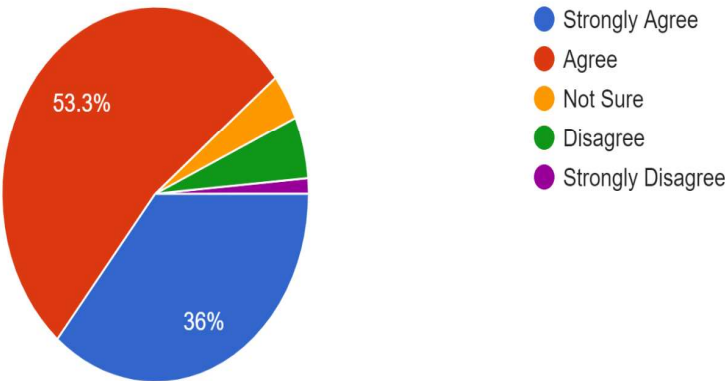
Students are disciplined and respect the Staff members

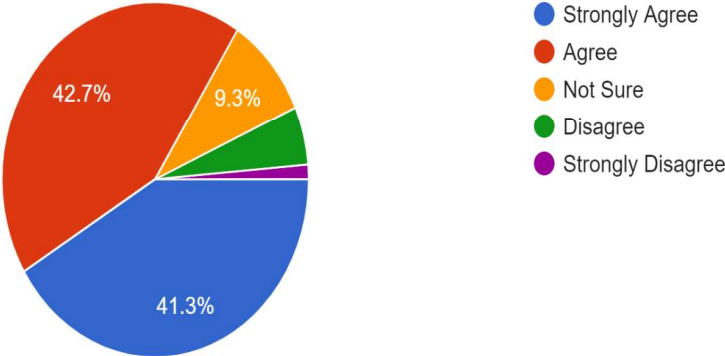

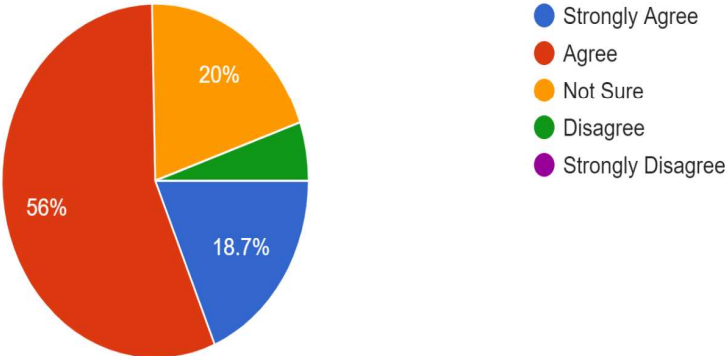
Equal opportunities for all staff is provided

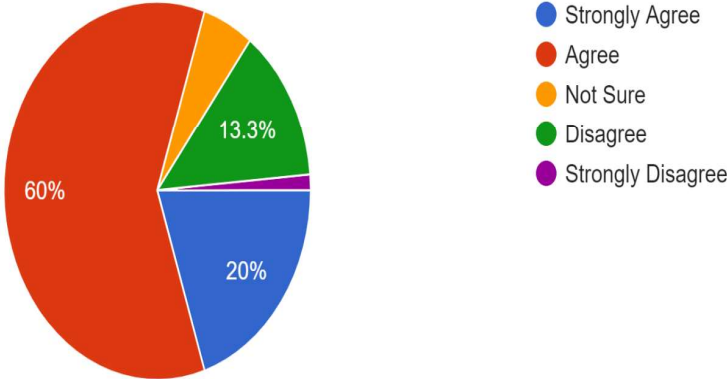
College has adequate medical facilities and is equipped to handle medical and other emergencies

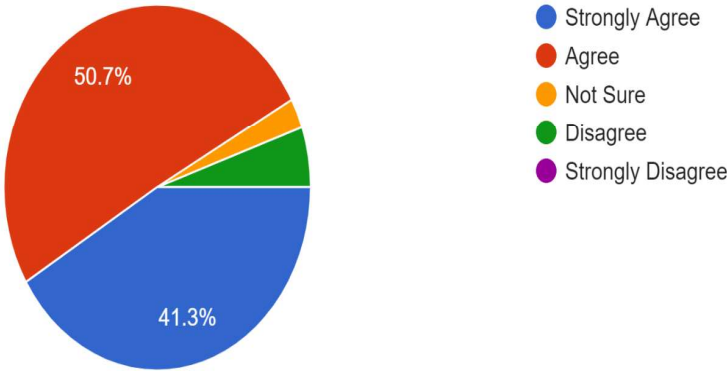
Rest rooms, toilets, laboratory, playground, classrooms are clean and well maintained

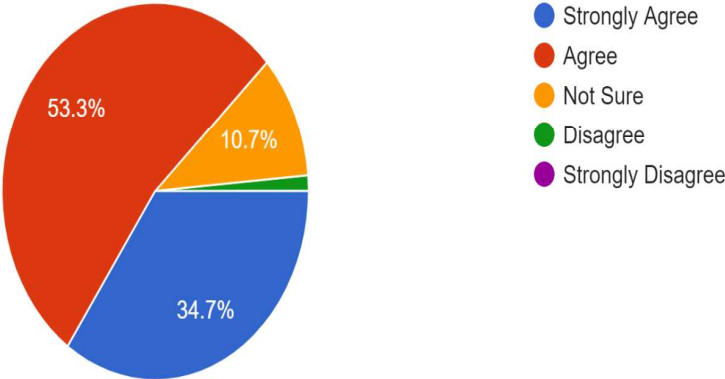
