## **BACHELOR OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS**

The college started BCA course w.e.f 2010 under self-financing scheme and sixty students are admitted in this course in every session through entrance exam. Out of 60 seats, forty seats are under subsidized category and twenty seats are under non-subsidized category. The course has added a new chapter in the achievement of the institution. The Department has excelled in various activities and it is a matter of great pride that in the session (2022-23) our student Ms. Shreya got selected in a multinational company "Capgemini", and Ms. Amanjyoti of BCA 6th semester got selected in the Indian postal services. Two students got selected in defence services and many got selected in CUHP and HPU Shimla for pursuing higher studies. The mission of the course remains to equip the learners with latest technology and to shape the character of the students to lead the society in the right direction and to contribute in their best spirits in multidisciplinary fields for making Mother India as a great Nation and becoming a global leader. At present, there are 160 students in this department.

# **SCHOOL OF COMPUTER AND ENGINEERING**

## **DEPARTMENT OF MCA & B.TECH (CSE)**

The School of Computer Science & Engineering at Govt. College Dharamshala offers B. Tech(Computer Science and Engineering) and Masters in Computer Application (MCA) programme to create motivated, innovative, creative thinking graduates to fill ICT positions across sectors who can conceptualize, design, analyse, and develop ICT applications to meet the modern day requirements. B.Tech (CSE) is a four-year degree course spread over eight semester's course and MCA is a two year degree course spread over four semesters affiliated to Himachal Pradesh Technical University Hamirpur. These courses are approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi.

The school of Computer Science & Engineering provides industrial visits, training, seminars, workshops on latest software technologies and study tours to the students. The college has career guidance and placement cell which is working very efficiently for the placement of students in MNCs. The department has a well qualified and trained faculty as per AICTE norms.

### **Bachelors of Technology B.Tech (CSE):**

- ◆ Computer Science Engineering (CSE) encompasses a variety of topics that relates to computation, like development of algorithms, analyses of algorithms, programming languages, software design and computer hardware.
- ◆ Computer science engineering has roots in electrical engineering, mathematics, and linguistics.
- ◆ In the past Computer Science was taught as part of mathematics or engineering field.
- ◆ In the present information era(Knowledge era) computer science and engineering will see an exponential growth as the future machine work on artificial intelligence.

### **Master of Computer Application (MCA):**

- ◆ The college started Master of Computer Application (MCA) w.e.f session 2012-15 under the school of Computer Science & Engineering. It is a two year degree course spread over four semester and is affiliated to HPTU, Hamirpur and is approved by

AICTE. The department provides industrial visit and training, seminars, workshops on latest software technologies and study tour to the students.

- ◆ The college has a guidance and placement cell which is working very effectively for the placement of students in MNCs. The department has a well qualified and trained faculty as per AICTE norms.
- ◆ Our students have bagged four university positions in 2022. Two in MCA (1<sup>st</sup> year) and two position in MCA (II<sup>nd</sup> year) in the merit list of HPTU. This department is touching the heights of success with flying colors.

In the current session, the total no. of students in B.Tech is 256 and the total strength in MCA is 394. There is cut-throat competition for admission in these courses and both the department are shining in each and every field.

## **B.SC. BIOTECHNOLOGY**

The college started B.Sc. Biotechnology course from the session 2012 under self financing scheme. Thirty students are admitted in this course in every session on the basis of merit list of their 12<sup>th</sup> class. All the seats are filled under subsidized category.

The course has created a land mark in the achievements of the institution. One student of B.Sc. Biotechnology 3<sup>rd</sup> year got selected for the final round in Cipla Pharmaceuticals. One student got selected in Amazon and some others are under admission process in Punjab University, HPU etc. for higher studies.

During this session, the department conducted a lecture on “Nano Biotechnology” for the students. In this session, students were trained to create new biomedical research tools, diagnostic tests and drug delivery system. The mission of this course remains to create awareness about the potential of biotechnology in socio-ethical implications and instill spirit of innovation and creativity among students with sound research and aptitude.

## **IGNOU**

IGNOU study centre (1105) has the privilege to be considered as one of the biggest study centre of Himachal Pradesh and was started in the college in 1989. The centre caters to the needs of the students of six districts of Himachal Pradesh because there are some special courses which are available only at this study centre.

The strength of the centre has increased to almost twenty five hundred. The result of this

centre is invariably more than the result of state universities. This is the only centre in Himachal Pradesh where the students from Northern India come for various degrees, diplomas and courses. At present, this study center offers more than 59 courses to the students and a tele-conference was also organized for the approved counselors of the study center.

## **NSS: NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME**

The college has very energetic two units of NSS, working together under the able guidance of two NSS programme officers. Both the units have 200 volunteers, comprising of 94 boys and 106 girls. ## **BACHELOR OF VOCATION**

**Nodal Officer: Dr. Ajay Kumar Choudhary**

B.Voc degree programmers are offered in 18 colleges across the state. B.Voc in Govt. College Dharamshala was incepted in 2017.This is a 3 year degree course after higher



secondary or intermediate college with multiple entry and exit points. Students completing the first year get a diploma certificate, after second year they get the advanced diploma certificate and after completion of three years, the B.Voc. degree is awarded. The course curriculum has 40% general education (theory) and 60% vocational training (practical) components. These programs follow semester system and offer credits after completion of the course.

The students who have enrolled in B.Voc courses appreciate the practical focus and are confident that their chances of getting a suitable job are higher than other graduates. These courses are expected to comply with NSQF and are financially aided by the UGC (University Grant Commission). The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on skills development based higher education as part of college/university education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) degree with multiple exits such as diploma/advanced diploma under the NSQF. The B.Voc. program is focused on universities and colleges providing undergraduate studies which would also incorporate specific job roles and their NOSs along with broad based general education. This would enable the graduates completing B.Voc. to make a meaningful participation in accelerating India's economy by gaining appropriate employment, becoming entrepreneurs and creating appropriate knowledge.
