**STAFF:-**

## BACHELOR OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS

The college started BCA course w.e.f 2010 under self-financing scheme and sixty students were admitted in this course in every session through entrance exams. Out of 60 seats, forty seats are under subsidized category and twenty seats are under non-subsidized category. The course has added a new chapter in the achievement of the institution. The Department has excelled in various activities and it is a matter of great pride that in the session (2023-24) our student **Mr. Ayush Kapoor** got selected in a multinational company “TCS”. Two students (**Mr. Kartik Rana, Parikshit Pathania**) got selected in defence services and many got selected in CUHP, HPU Shimla for pursuing higher studies. The guest lecture on the topic “**Introduction to UI and UX**”, a new technology was organized for the students. The mission of the course remains to inculcate OLQ i.e. (Officer like qualities) and to develop the character among the students so as to lead the society in the right direction and to contribute in their best spirits in multidisciplinary fields for developing Mother India as a great Nation becoming a global leader.

## PGDCA

The first batch of PGDCA was started in the session 2007-08 with 40 seats (+1) (Supernumerary single girl Child). Out of 40, 30 seats are in the category of subsidized and the remaining 10 seats are under the non-subsidized category. It is matter of great pride that the students of this department got placements in various public and private sectors. The mission of this course remains to develop the personality and talent of the students and make them capable to carve a niche for themselves in the modern age of

information and technology. For this academic session 120 students applied online, and all 40 seats were filled.

BBA (Bachelor of Business Administration) is running successfully in the Govt PG College Dharamshala since 1997. The management is continuously aiming to meet the objectives of training and meeting manpower requirements for junior management positions. ## **MASTERS OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION**

The Department of MBA has shown its presence not only in the state but also in the country as the students from this course have carved a niche for themselves in various organizations, MNC's and banks. The total strength in both the semesters is 140 (2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sem). The students of MBA from this institution always find a place in the merit list of the University. The admission to this course is a mazy affair as the students have to face a cut throat competition in order to secure their seat in the classrooms of this renowned institution. The written test is conducted by Himachal Pradesh Technical University and no student is entertained without sitting in the examination but if the seats remain vacant, they can be allotted on the basis of their score in graduation. From this session, New Education Policy was also implemented successfully and the students of first year are being taught the syllabus of New Education Policy. The vary first month of the new session commenced with the bang as Department of MBA organized Orientation Programme for new students which ended up as an eye opener and curtain raiser as the resource persons were connoisseurs from diverse backgrounds. Besides, few special lectures were also arranged for both the semesters in which the presence was 100 percent. In the current session, a new podium was also added in the department which is of immense use to the teachers as well as to the students. The new building of MBA is under construction and hopefully it will be made available to the students in the next session. The students of last year have already completed their summer internship with various organizations of the country like Times Group, various banks and Nimbus academy. Two industrial visits were arranged for the students of first year and second year respectively. The students of first year visited Verka, Times Group and Morpen Pharmaceuticals whereas the students of last year visited the plant of Coca Cola in Goa along with exposure of seeing various sites, keeping in mind, the exposure for tourism industry. Besides academic, the students of management make their presence felt in all the competitions and functions of the college and win many prizes. A pre placement talk was also

arranged for the students in which 100 students participated and approximately 50 students responded back to the Development Logics ( IT Sector). In order to give the opportunity to the students to fulfill the requirement of the corporate world special emphasis is given on the Placements of the students in the Department. Department is planning to have a collaborative Placement Drive with different organizations in which students will get a chance to fulfill the requirements of the Corporate World and the process has already been initiated. Ms. Ankita Sood has presented a paper in National Conference Bharat Vision 2047 on the topic “Leaky Pipeline for Women Leaders”. Dr. Meghna Sood has attended an FDP on the topic “Emerging trends in Management Philosophy” from Tata Group of Institutions.

The School of Computer Science & Engineering at Govt. College Dharamshala offers B. Tech. (Computer Science and Engineering) and Masters in Computer Application (MCA) programme to create motivated, innovative, creative thinking graduates to fill ICT positions across sectors that can conceptualize, design, analyze, and develop ICT applications to meet the modern day requirements. B.Tech (CSE) is a four-year degree course spread over eight semester's course and MCA is a two year degree course spread over four semester's affiliated to Himachal Pradesh Technical University Hamirpur. These courses are approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi.

The school of Computer Science & Engineering provides industrial visits, training, seminars, workshops on latest software technologies and study tours to the students. The college has career guidance and placement cell which is working very efficiently for the placement of students in MNCs. The department has a well qualified and trained faculty as per AICTE norms.

**Bachelors of Technology B.Tech (CSE):**

The department provides industrial visit and training, seminars, workshopson latest software technologies and study tour to the students.
- ◆ The college has a guidance and placement cell which is working very effectively forthe placement of students in MNCs. The department has a well qualified and trainedfaculty as per AICTE norms.
- ◆ Our students have bagged four university positions in 2023. Two in MCA (1<sup>st</sup> year)and two position in MCA (II<sup>nd</sup> year) in the merit list of HPTU. This department is touching the heights of success with flying colors.

Faculty members of Department of MCA & B. Tech. CSE have presented more than 10

research papers at various National and International conferences. Dr. Pawan Thakur Assistant Professor Department of Computer Science and Engineering has written four books for the students of 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12 classes as per the CBSE curriculum. Dr. Sachin Awasthi Assistant Professor Department of Computer Science and Engineering has written book for the students of 12<sup>th</sup> class as per the CBSE curriculum.

In the current session, the total no. of students in B.Tech is 292 and the total strength in MCA is 135. There is cut-throat competition for admission in these courses and both the department is shining in each and every field.

### **B.SC. BIOTECHNOLOGY**

The college started B.Sc. Biotechnology Course w.e.f. the Session 2012-2013 onwards under the self financing scheme. Thirty Students are admitted in 1<sup>st</sup> year in this course in every session on the basis of merit list of their twelfth class results. All the seats are filled under subsidized category. The department has well-qualified, committed and trained faculty as per UGC norms. The department has well established infrastructure with two biotechnology lab having all the instruments for the practical concerned.

The department has considerable achievements in its account. Seven students have enrolled in higher studies in H.P. University and two students have joined Punjab University. Time to time visit of various resource persons are made available during the session which are highly concerned to the students. In the session 2023-2024 Department has organized one day workshop on “Next Generation Sequencing and Carrier Avenues in Biotechnology” which was delivered by Dr.Sandeep Swargam ,Asst. Prof. in the Department of Computational Biology and Bioinformatics centre at CUHP.

During this session department has conducted science quiz, declamation competition and many interactive sessions that contributes to the overall grooming of the students. One student of B.Sc. Biotechnology of 3<sup>RD</sup> year (Deepali Mankotia) participated in the inter college tournament in chess (2023-2024) session held at Govt. College Amb .The mission of this course remains to create awareness about the Potential of Biotechnology in socio-ethical implications, to instill spirit of innovation and creativity among students with sound scientific temperament in research contributing in building up India as a great nation.

### **IGNOU**

IGNOU study centre (1105) has the privilege to be considered as one of the biggest study centre of Himachal Pradesh and was started in the college in 1989. ### **Introduction about the Bachelor of Vocation Degree Program (B. Voc.):**

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on skill development based job oriented higher education program as a part of College/ University education leading to Bachelor of Vocation Degree (B.Voc.). This degree Program is unique with the provision of multiple entry and exist at different levels of NSQF from level 5 to 7 viz. Diploma, Advance Diploma and Degree in compliance to the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF). Multiple entry and exit will allow students the flexibility to earn and study as per their convenience. B.Voc degree programs are offered in 20 colleges across Himachal Pradesh governed by DOHE and HPKVN collaboration with different training service provider companies. In Govt. Degree College Dharamshala Edubridge Learning Pvt. Ltd. appointed as TSP for B.Voc. This is a 3 years Degree Program after Higher Secondary or Intermediate College with multiple entry and exit points. The course curriculum has 40% general education (theory) and 60% vocational training (practical) components. These programs follow semester system and offer credits after completion of the course.

Job Role/NSQF levels:- There is 4 (Level 4,5,6 and 7) different levels in each sector having different skill job role.

**Other curriculum activities:** In B.Voc Retail Management and Hospitality& Tourism we arranged other curriculum activities like orientation programs, guest lecturers (4 guest lecturers per level by industry/field experts), Field visits.

3. The work of multipurpose hall in the MCA department is also started.
4. The new science block is near completion.
