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Annual review meeting of students' outcomes in academics, co-curricular, extracurricular and extension activities and action taken thereof

An Annual review meeting on students' outcomes in academics, co-curricular, extracurricular, and extension activities for the session 2023-24 was held under the chairmanship of worthy principal Sh Rakesh Pathania in coordination with IQAC on 17th Sep. 2024.

Agenda of the meeting:

1. Review of academic outcomes of the students.

5. Plan of action for the next academic session for achieving excellence.

At the outset of the meeting IQAC coordinator Dr V.S.Vats extended warm welcome to worthy Principal Sh. Rakesh Pathania, members of Teaching and non-Teaching staff and discussed the agenda points in detail one by one as follows:

1. **Review of academic outcomes of the students:** During the meeting, the annual academic performance of the students including their GPA, pass percentage and underperformance was thoroughly discussed and analyzed. Different areas where students have faced challenges were identified. It was also observed that the students were diligent and hardworking, showing significant potential for improvement with the right guidance and support. Feedback gathered from students on their learning experiences was also discussed in the meeting.

2. **Review of students' outcomes in co-curricular activities:** In the meeting, the outcomes of students' performance and participation in co-curricular activities such as such as involvement in debates, quizzes, clubs and societies were thoroughly discussed and analyzed. It was observed that participation rate was little low and only a some specific students showed interest in these activities throughout the session although faculty members actively encouraged students to participate by emphasizing the significant role these activities play in their holistic development.

3. **Review of students' outcomes in extra-curricular activities:** In the meeting, the outcomes of students' participation in extra-curricular activities were thoroughly reviewed, focusing on areas such as sports, cultural events as well as participation in college, state and national events.

4. **Review of students' outcomes in extension activities :** In the meeting, the outcomes of students' participation in extension activities, particularly in the areas of community outreach and social responsibility, were thoroughly reviewed. Key areas of focus included participation in community service, environmental initiatives, social awareness campaigns, and collaborations with local community. It was noted that the

college NSS, NCC, Rovers and Rangers units, various clubs and societies had organized several impactful events, such as a cleanliness drive, plantation drive, and a literacy campaigns.

Plan of Action for the next academic session 2024-25 for achieving excellence:

It was decided in the meeting to construct new library hall for self finance courses and a guest house for visitors. It was decided to enhance access to learning resources like digital tools, more focus on teaching methods such as flipped classrooms, blended learning and problem-based learning to improve student engagement and understanding. Additionally, students identified as underperforming will be provided with extra support through remedial classes and personalized mentoring, ensuring they receive the attention needed to strengthen their academic performance.

For the upcoming academic session, efforts will be made to increase student participation in co-curricular, extra-curricular and extension activities. Students will also be encouraged to take on leadership roles in organizing and managing events such as workshops, seminars, sports etc. These initiatives aim to develop students' organizational skills, leadership abilities, and sense of initiative.

In the upcoming academic session, student involvement in extension activities will be expanded with the collaboration with the society. The college plans to organize additional campaigns focusing on critical issues such as drug addiction prevention, AIDS awareness, literacy promotion, health awareness programmes and cleanliness initiatives. These campaigns will be extended to cover more villages and slum areas.
