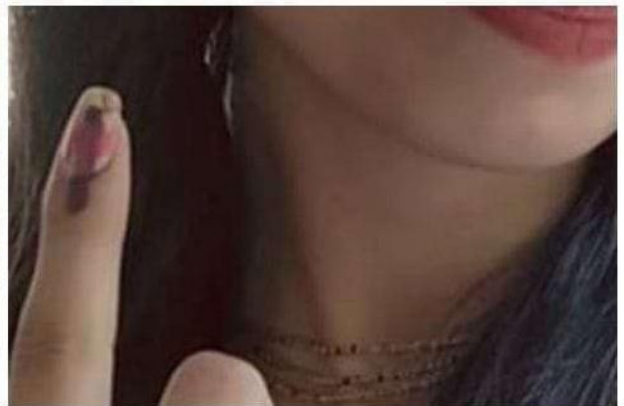

16TH October 2024

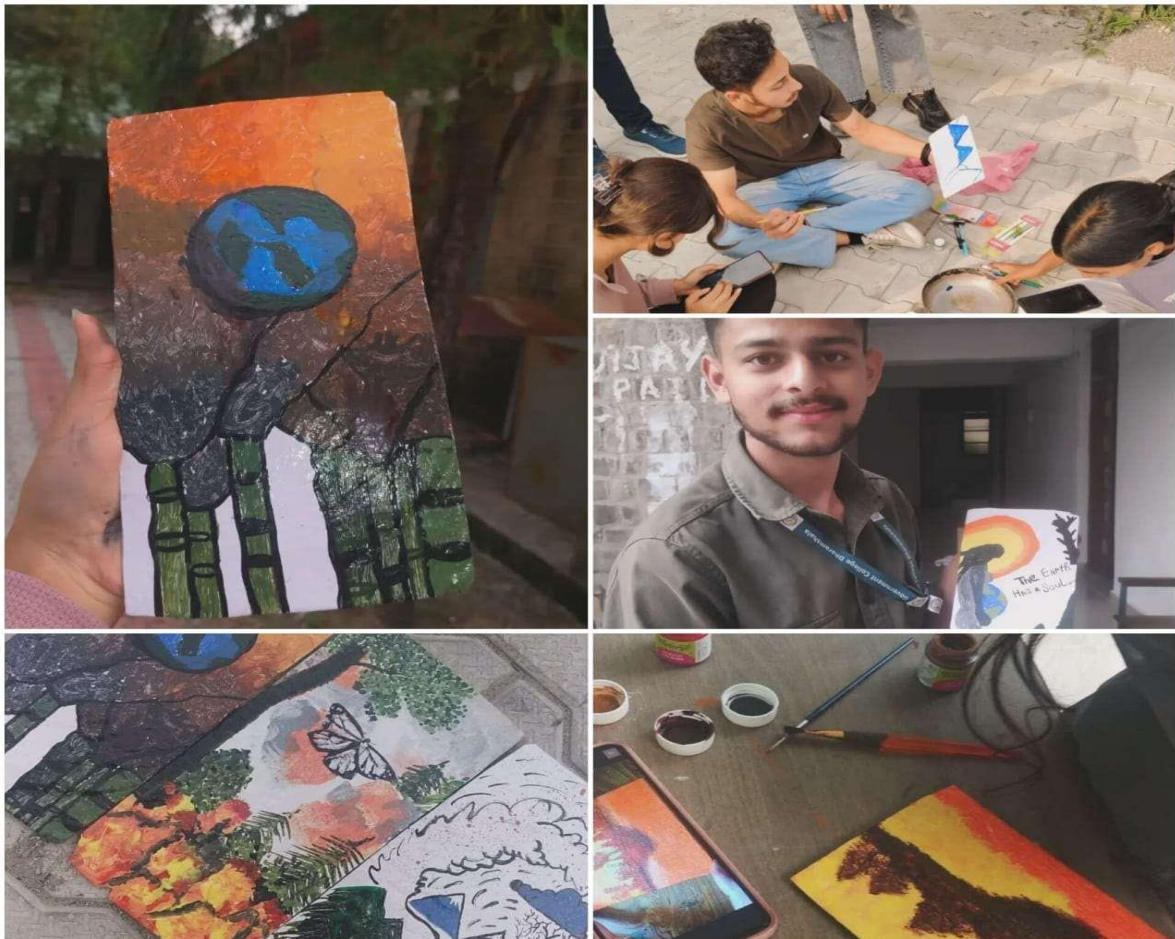
Government College Dharamshala. The NSS unit conducted a cleanliness drive in the college campus in which the entire college campus was cleaned.

12Th November 2024

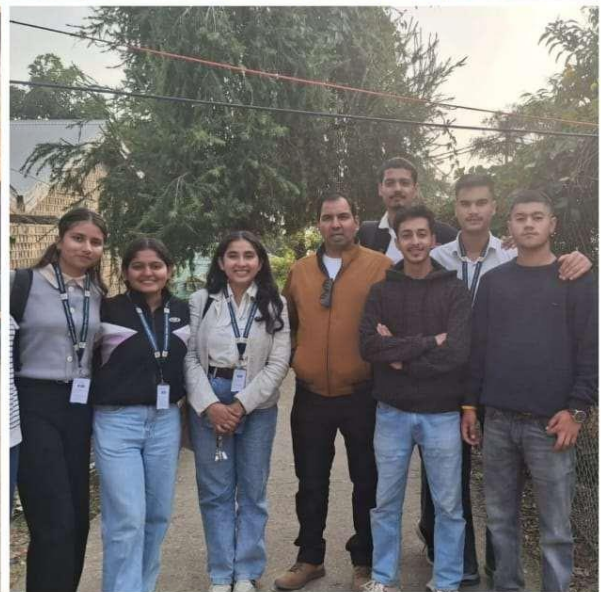

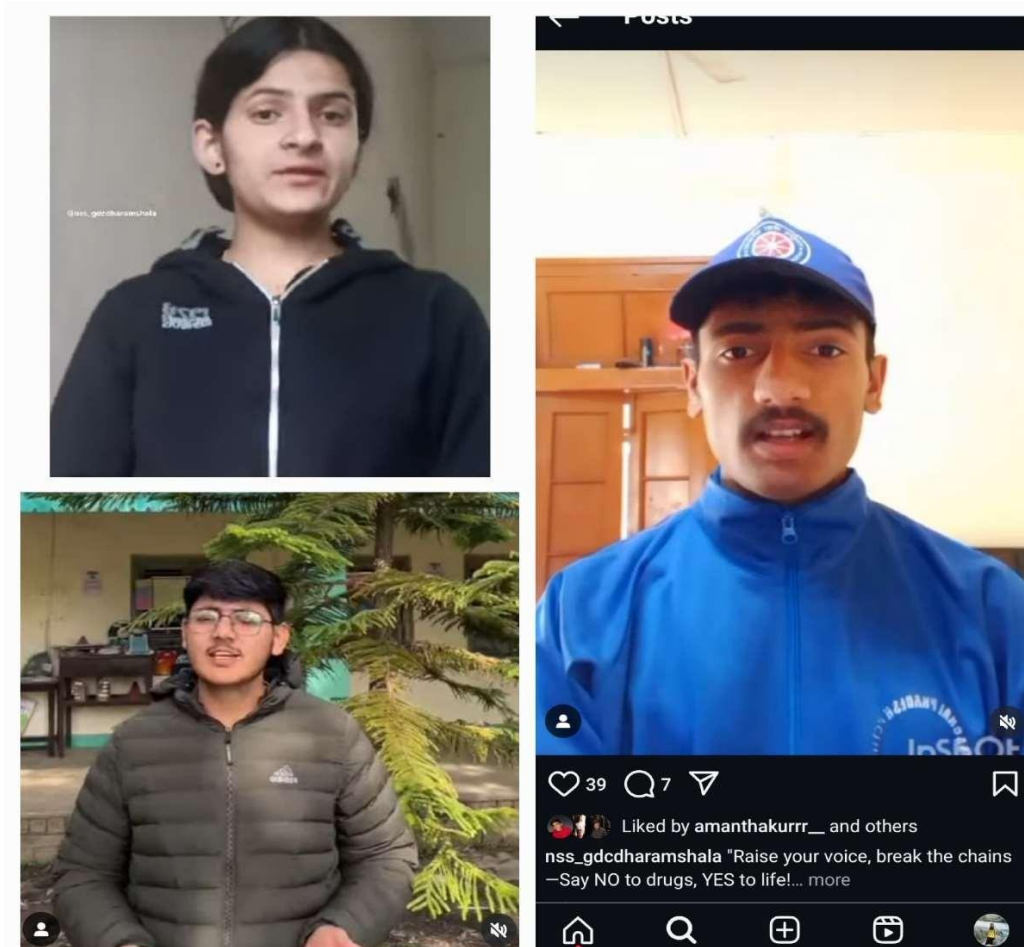
Volunteers of NSS government college Dharamshala participated in cleanliness drive in collaboration with waste warriors NGO at Bhagsunag Dharamshala.
