Rovers & Rangers Activities 2024-25

Activity 1

The session began with making the new students aware about the Rover and Ranger Club. A help desk was set up in the college campus for providing information about the activities of the club. The Rovers and Ranges visited the classrooms to share the details relating to the enrolment process of the new member to the club.

Activity 2

The enrolment for new students was conducted and new members were enrolled both has Rovers and Rangers. The club consists of 24 Ranges and 24 Rovers and enrolment was made for the vacancies created by the outgoing students.

CPR, first aid and other survival skills were also imparted to the students.
