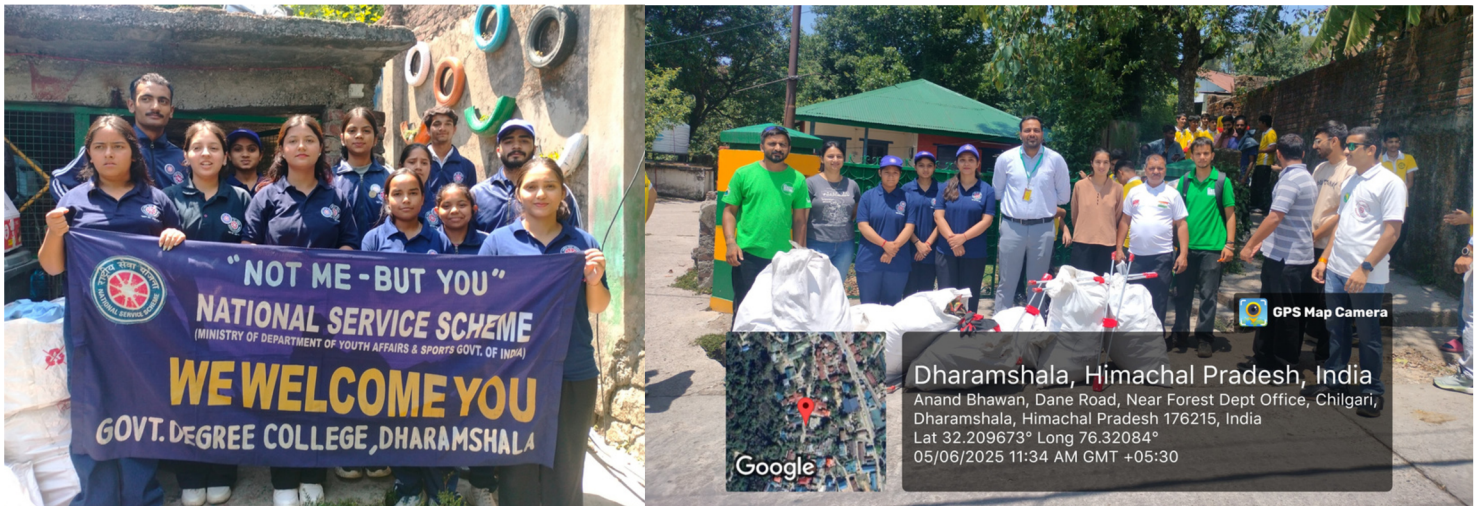




Government College Dharamshala National Service Scheme
